



## Scam Red Flags

*How do you know if it's a scam?*

If you can check one (1) or more of the boxes below, it's likely you are being targeted in a scam:

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> You receive an email, phone call or computer pop-up claiming you have been charged for a product or service you did not order.</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are told you were refunded too much money which must be returned immediately</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You receive an email or phone call claiming you owe money for an unpaid service, credit card bill or utility bill.</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are given instructions to send cash through a Bitcoin (digital currency) machine</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are instructed by an unknown person to send money via Zelle, Cash App or other money transfer application.</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are instructed to send money via a wire transfer to an unknown person or business</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are told your money is at risk and must be transferred to a secure account/location.</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are asked to purchase gift cards</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are told a family member is in trouble and needs money fast</li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are told you won a multi-million sweepstakes</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are instructed to keep a phone call or transaction confidential</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are instructed not to reveal the true purpose of a banking transaction.</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are asked for your bank account number, credit card number, or other personal identifying information</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are asked to allow remote access to your computer and/or online banking</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are asked for your username and password</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are asked to allow deposits to your account and then send the money to others</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are selling an item online and receive a check for an amount larger than asking price</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> You are threatened with legal action, shutting off services or being reported to the authorities.</li></ul> |
